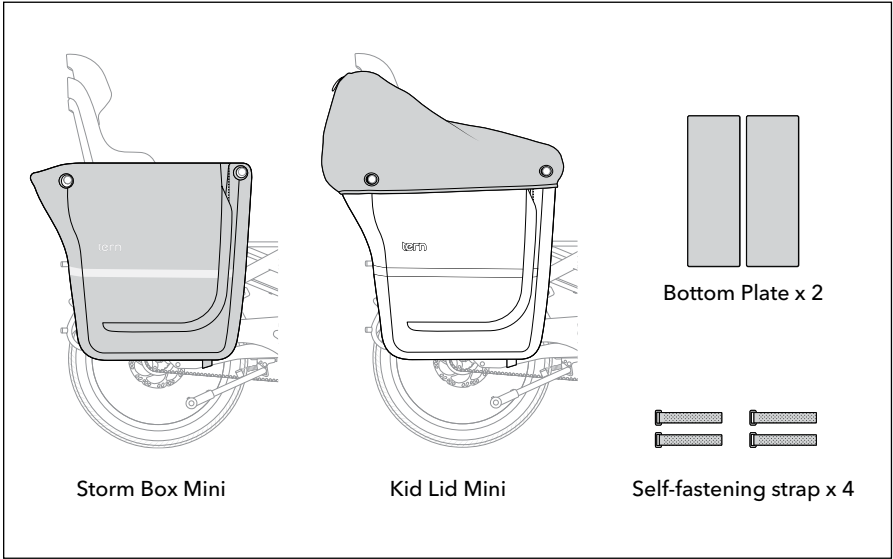

What's Included



How to Install Storm Box Mini

- ⚠ Additional accessories are required before Storm Box Mini can be installed. Please scan the QR code provided at the beginning of this manual for more details.
- ⚠ Depending on your passenger or cargo setup, your Clubhouse® Mini is equipped with a Flat Bar or a Child Seat Expansion Bar. The Storm Box Mini is compatible with both. However, vertical parking is only possible with the Flat Bar.

Preparation

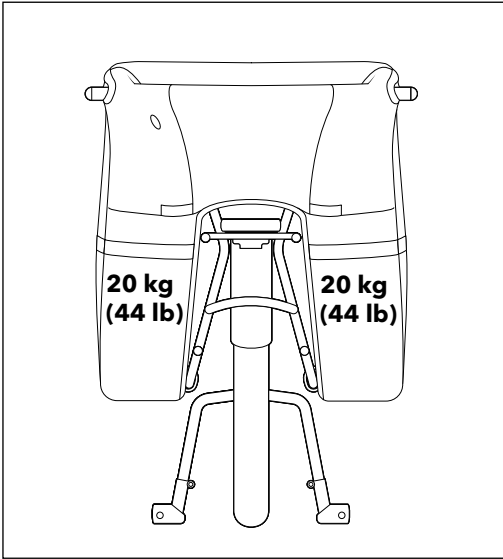
- Identify the front and rear sides. The rear side has a Tern logo.
- Ensure self-fastening strip in inner front side of the Storm Box Mini is unfastened.
- Ensure closure tabs in the middle of the Storm Box Mini are unfastened.

1. Place over Clubhouse Mini

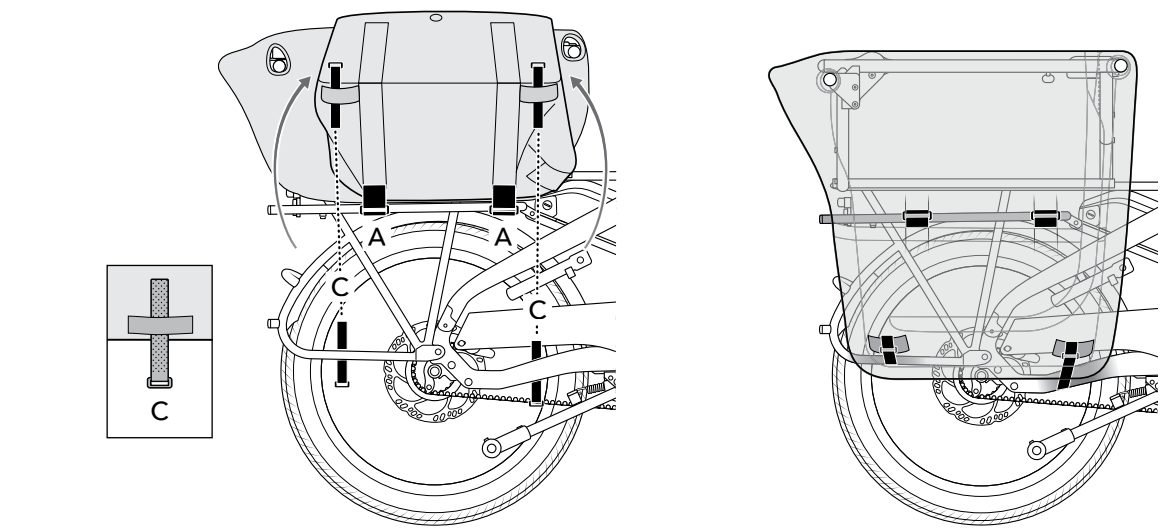
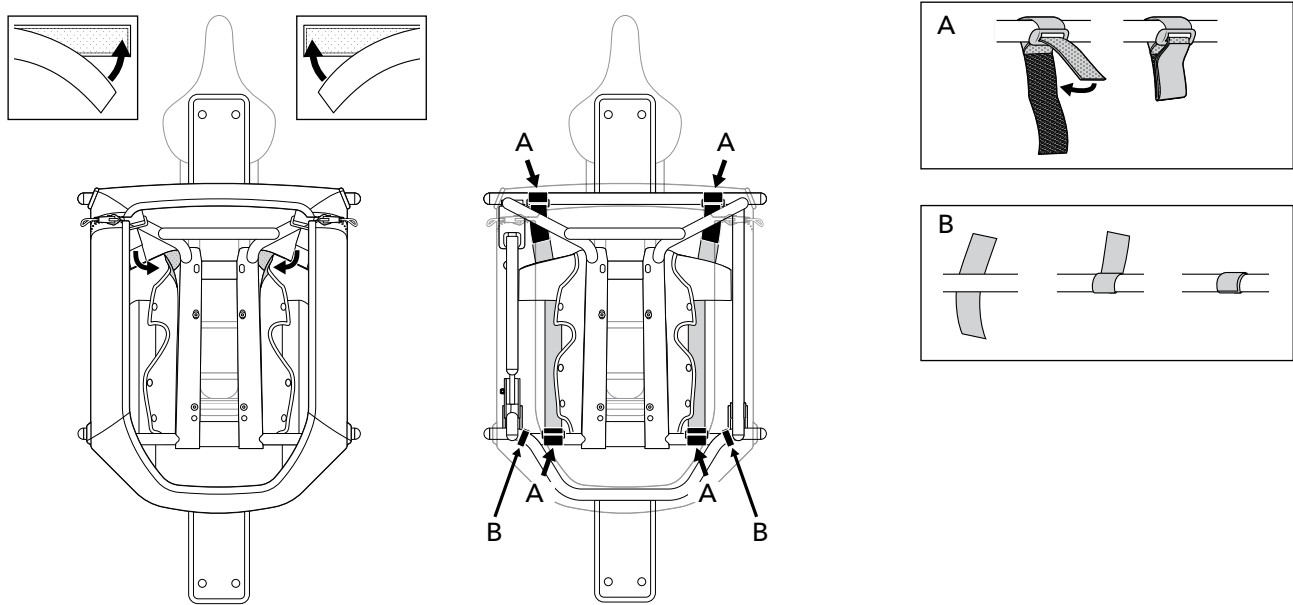
Make sure Storm Box Mini does not cover the vertical standing supports.

Weight Limit

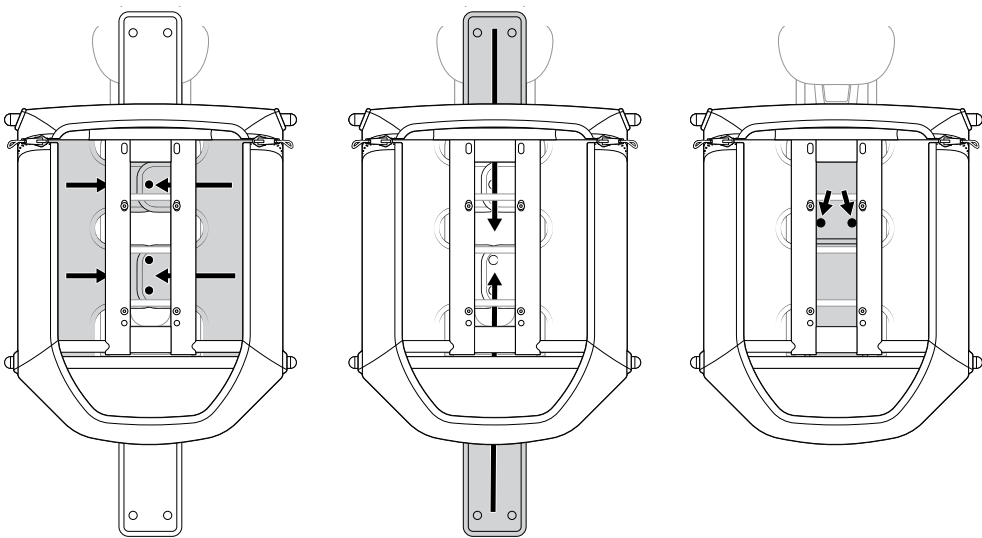
⚠ Do not exceed 40 kg (88 lb)



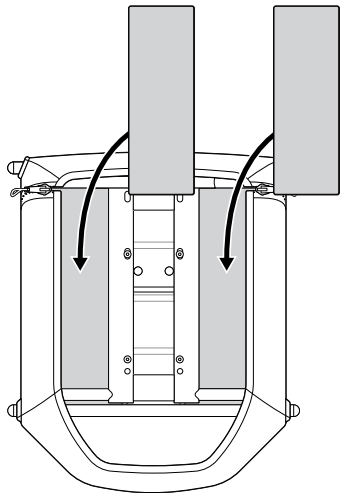
2. Fasten to rails using self-fastening straps



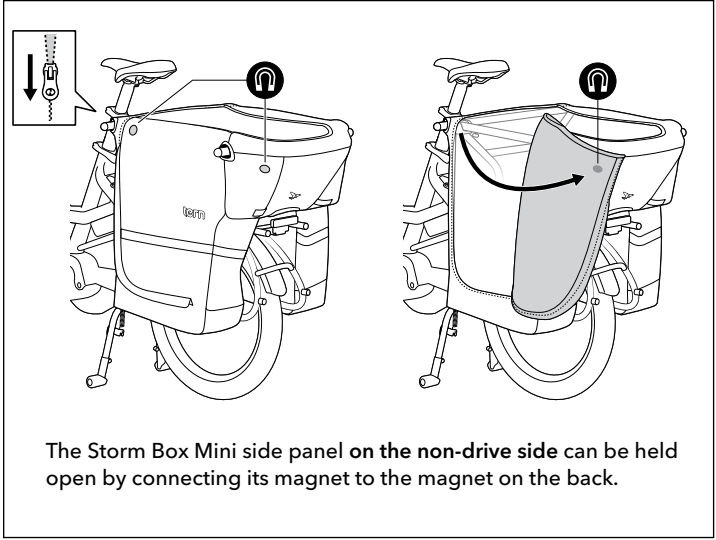
3. Buckle middle tabs



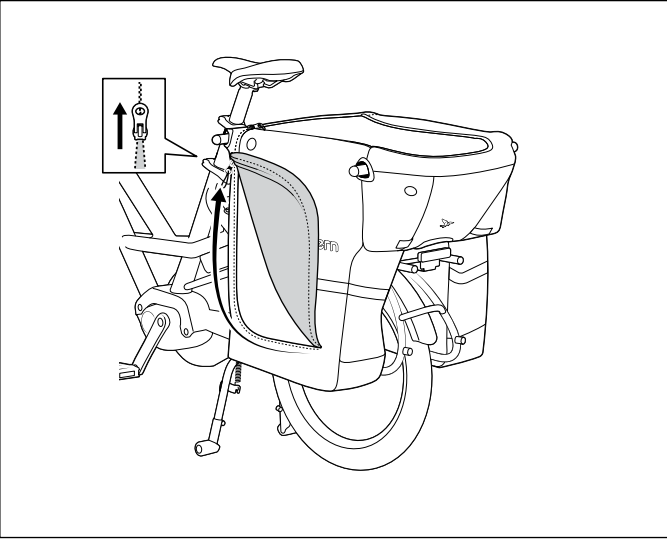
4. Insert Bottom Plates



How to Use Side Panel Magnet

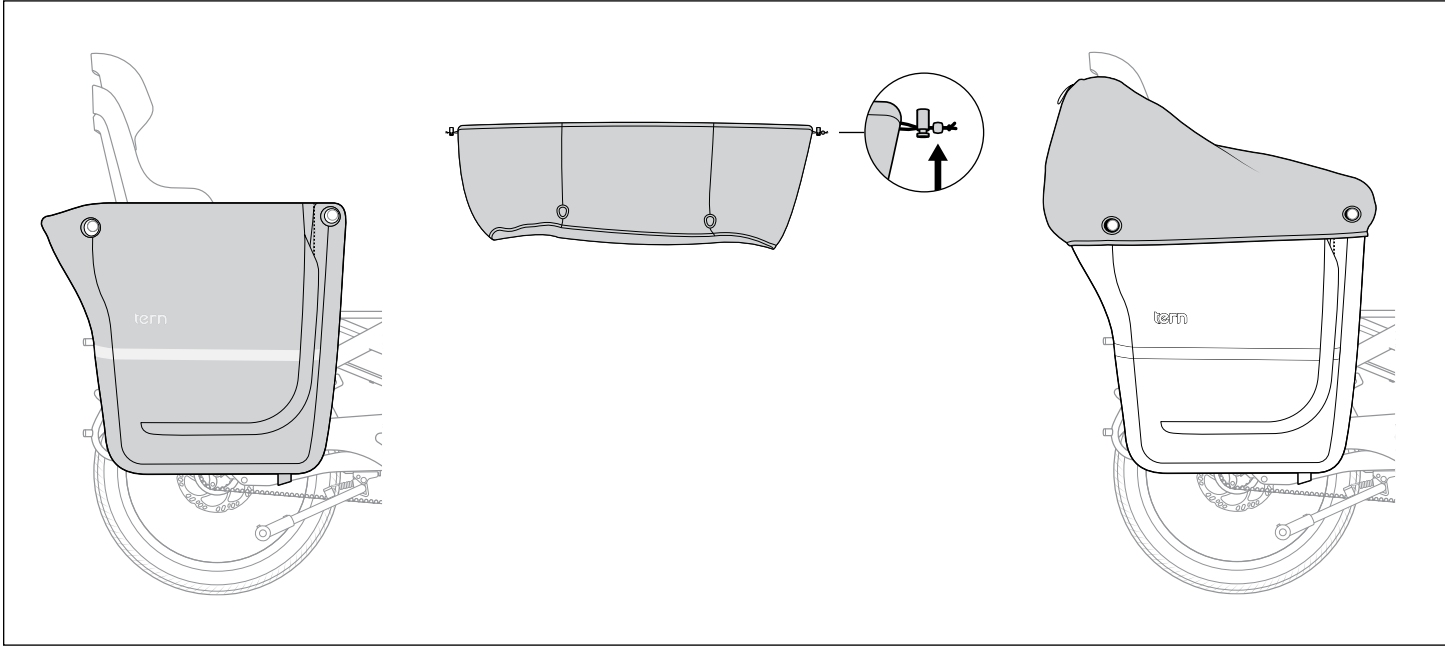


How to Access Lower Compartment

⚠ Identify the front and rear sides. The front side uses a grey bead.



How to Clean

Wipe using dampened cloth with mild soap. Allow Storm Box Mini to fully dry before storing.

⚠ Do not use bleach or other harsh chemicals.

⚠ Do not machine wash or machine dry.

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Carrying Rear Passengers

Before carrying passengers, it's important to familiarize yourself with your bike's capabilities by referring to its User Manual or QuickStart Guide.

WARNINGS

- Your bike may behave differently with passengers onboard, particularly in terms of balance, steering, and braking. Practice handling the bike in a safe area before riding with passengers on public roads.
- Do not leave children unattended on the bike, even if it is on the kickstand. Wiggling children can upset the balance of the bike and a fall may result in serious injuries.
- If your bike has been parked outdoors, check all passenger contact surfaces for heat to prevent burns.

Safety Notes

⚠ Follow the Law

Check your local regulations before carrying passengers. Some jurisdictions don't allow passengers, others require special accessories, and some limit the number or age of passengers.

⚠ Stay Within the Weight Limits

Always follow the weight limits listed in your bike and accessory manuals, including the bike's maximum gross vehicle weight (MGVW). **The combined weight of the bike (with battery), accessories, rider, passengers, and cargo must not exceed the MGVW for safe riding.**

⚠ Know Your Riding Condition

Keep both tires on the ground when riding with passengers. Do not carry passengers on unimproved or unmaintained natural-surface trails.

⚠ Keep Your Bike Steady for Passengers

Before loading or unloading passengers, make sure the bike is stable and parked on a firm, level surface. If passengers mount or dismount on their own, hold the bike steady to prevent tipping.

⚠ Ensure Your Bike Setup is Safe & Secure

- Before each trip, check that accessories have been correctly installed and secured, and ensure there are no loose items on the bike or on your passenger(s) that may get caught in moving bike parts. Keep sharp objects away from children, and suitably cover any coil springs (e.g. under the saddle) to prevent trapping of fingers.
- Regularly check your bike setup for worn or damaged parts. Always use genuine replacements and replace any damaged parts immediately, either by a qualified mechanic or following the manufacturer's instructions.

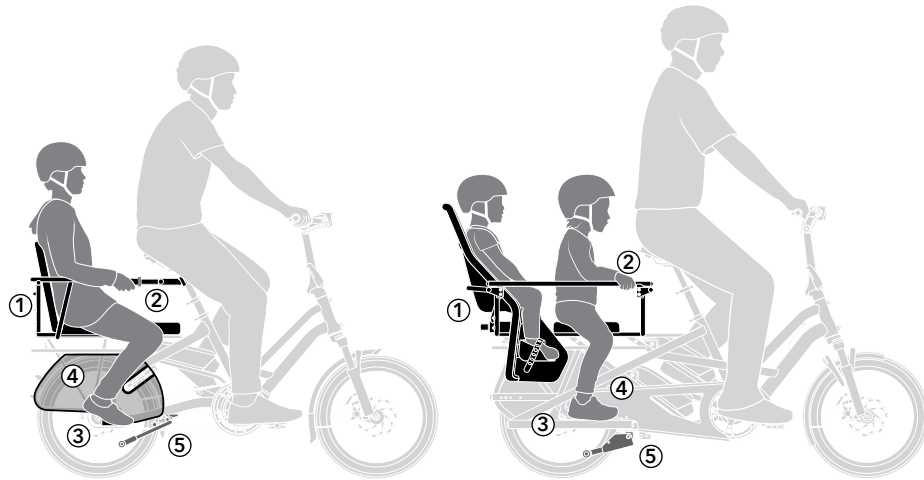
⚠ Use Helmet & Proper Clothing

Always follow local helmet laws. For safety, riders and passengers are strongly advised to wear an approved helmet. In cold or wet weather, dress young passengers warmly and protect them from the elements.

Use a Suitable Passenger Setup

⚠ Your bike must have proper accessories for the following purposes to safely carry rear passenger(s):

1. **Seating***. Purpose-built rear seating, chosen according to the passenger's needs
2. **Handhold**. Something for the passenger to hold on to, other than the bike itself
3. **Foot support**. Fixed platforms or dedicated foot rests on both sides of the bike
4. **Foot and leg protection**. Something to prevent feet and legs from getting caught in the spinning wheel
5. **Double kickstand**. Dual-leg stand with a wide stance for extra stability when loading or unloading passengers



* Only use seating suitable for your passenger's age and size, and follow the seat manufacturer's instructions for compatibility, installation, use, and maintenance. Child passengers should be able to sit unaided for the duration of the ride. Always secure them with the provided restraint system, and regularly check that their height and weight remain within the manufacturer's limits.

Note: The illustrations show examples of gear for safely carrying rear passengers. Your setup may vary. Tern's seating, handhold, and foot support accessories are not intended for lifting the bike or bearing heavy loads, unless specified, as this may damage the bike or accessories.
